Hydrafacial

Pre Care

- Let your provider know if you have ever taken oral isotretinoin (Sotret, Claravis, Myorisan, Amnesteem, Absorica, Accutane)
- Discontinue use of topical prescriptive medications for 48 hours (Retin-A, Tazorac, Differin, EpiDuo, Ziana)
- Refrain from any type of exfoliating treatments (Glycolic, Enzymes) to the area of treatment for 48 hours.
- Refrain from waxing and use of depilatories for 48 hours.
- Discontinue use of OTC acne medication (Benzoyl Peroxide, Salicylic) for 72 hours.
- If you are prone to cold sores, Hydrafacial may cause a break out; ask your provider for a prophylactic prescription such as Valtrex.
- Avoid sun exposure and or tanning creams/sprays for at least 72 hours.
- No toxin or filler injections for 2 weeks before.
- Shaving is not recommended before treatment. If you choose to shave, please shave at least 3-4 hours prior to your treatment.

Post Care

- Your skin may experience temporary irritation, tightness, or redness. These are all normal reactions that typically resolve within 72 hours depending on skin sensitivity.
- You may experience tingling and stinging during the treatment. These sensations generally subside within 3 hours of treatment.
- The treated area is more susceptible to sunburn, sun damage and hyperpigmentation. Avoid direct sun exposure for at least 48 hours and use a minimum of 30 SPF mineral sunscreen. This to prevent UV rays from damaging your skin which interferes with the benefits of Hydrafacial.
- Aggressive exfoliation, waxing and products containing acids or retinols should be avoided in the treatment area for a minimum of 48 hours.
- Injectables can be used after HydraFacial.
- Avoid heat (e.g. sauna and/or intense cardio) for 24 hours.
- Best to wait overnight before applying make up.

- Topical prescriptive medication may be resumed in 48 hours.
- OTC acne medication may be resumed in 48 hours.
